PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The nuns of Dolma Ling Nunnery have requested financial support to provide a work stand for the nuns to create sand mandalas, as well as additional furniture for their dining room and classrooms.

Officially inaugurated in 2005 by His Holiness the Dalai Lama, Dolma Ling Nunnery and Institute in northern India is a center of learning and scholarship where women can be recognized for their deep understanding of Buddhist history, practice, and principles. This non-sectarian nunnery is open to Buddhist nuns from all traditions and lineages.

Since it was built, the nunnery population has almost tripled in size. In 2017, Dolma Ling has accepted 20 new nuns, bringing the total number to 227. Although the nunnery has most of the furniture required to accommodate these new nuns, a small amount needs to be made.

We need your help to fund:

- A work stand for the nuns so they may learn how to construct sand mandalas;
- Two dining tables;
- Two benches for the dining room; and
- To improve and increase the classroom furniture.

All of the furniture items will be made out of wood and plywood, in keeping with the rest of the furniture in the nunnery.
